Meeting with Des Moines County Emergency Management Coordinator

On September 11, 2018 I met with the Des Moines County Emergency Management Coordinator, Gina Hardin, to discuss the CCR Emergency Action Plan, and provide information on the CCR rule and view the CCR impoundments.


This meeting started at 09:00 AM with discussions about the CCR rule and how it impacts BGS.

Burlington was experiencing major flooding at the time of the visit. The flood level was cresting at 18.6 ft. I explained how flooding events where water went over levees were required to be inspected by a PE. We walked to the discharge point between the upper and lower ponds and saw how the flood waters were affecting the ponds.

We walked to the economizer ash pond and discussed the EPA inspection at BGS and how the economizer ash pond was re-engineered and re-configured to meet the impoundment requirements. I discussed the economizer ash pond retention as only holding 1 year of ash.

We discussed the every 7 day inspection requirement and the Annual Inspection requirement by a certified PE.

We briefly discussed the water sampling requirements of the CCR plan.
