## Meeting with the Allamakee County Emergency Coordinator

On August 9th, 2017 a representative from Alliant Energy met with the Allamakee County Emergency Coordinator (ACEC) to discuss the CCR emergency action plan, provide information on the CCR rule, and give a plant tour of the CCR units.

This meeting started at 9:00 a.m. and we discussed the purpose of the rule. I showed pictures from the TVA ash spill in 2008 to the ACEC so he would get an understanding for the development of the CCR rule.

Next we covered a training course provided annually to Lansing Generating Station employees. This training course outlines requirements in the CCR rule including inspection timelines and intention, vegetation requirements, and structural assessments of the embankments. We also covered the types of structural failures that can occur including: cracking, sloughing, boils, water seepage, and animal borrows.

Next we took a tour of the ash pond. During the tour we discussed work performed on the embankments including closing the lower pond and the placement of the bentonite wall. I let the ACEC know that we have passing grades on the structural integrity of the embankments.

Copies of the CCR Emergency Action Plan were passed on to the ACEC along with the emergency notification chart, and the Emergency Action Plan for the plant.
